Brief overview of the test

The Raven intelligence test is a psychological test developed by John C. Raven in 1936 that is used to measure human intelligence. The nonverbal test examines an individual's analytical and abstract thinking skills, does not require language skills, and can therefore be considered culturally neutral.

The test consists of a series of tasks, each containing increasingly complex patterns. The task is for the test subject to select the missing element from the options provided that completes the pattern.

The Raven intelligence test is widely used in educational institutions, workplace selection processes, and research because it effectively measures general intelligence.

The test consists of 60 questions, with 1 point awarded for each correct answer and 0 points for incorrect answers.

Possible results:

Very low: Below 30 points (intelligence level below 80)

Low: 31–38 points (intelligence level approx. 80–90)

Weak average: 39–46 points (intelligence level approx. 90–100)

Strong average: 47–51 points (intelligence level approx. 100–110)

Above average: 52–56 points (intelligence level approx. 110–120)

High: 57–59 points (intelligence level approx. 120–130)

Outstanding: 60 points (intelligence level 130 or above)

Intelligence refers to the totality of an individual's intellectual abilities, which they use to solve problems. This includes, among other things, speed of thought, understanding of relationships, and memory. The distribution of intellectual abilities follows a bell curve. Most people score in the middle of the bell curve, between 85 and 115, with an average IQ of 100.

Solving matrix-type tasks requires high-level logical skills, which facilitate the rapid recognition of complex situations and events and thinking about them. The essence of general intelligence is the ability to draw conclusions based on complex information, i.e., whether someone is able to see through stimuli and find connections between them.


